On the same day, 5th Dec 2016, a pilot training on Mensuration topic was launched in which 56 teachers have completed the training.

Launch of ChalkLit platform

Secretary Education, gov of Delhi, **Ms. Puniya Salila Shrivastava** launched the Chalklit platform on 5th Dec 2016 for Online Capacity Building Programs of teachers for SCERT Delhi.

Smooth adoption of the ChalkLit Platform

A total of eight trainings in both Maths and English was held in 2017. In each of the training around 300 to 600 teachers have participated.. Processes were built during this time and the tech and content were further improved.

A total of 2769 teachers have participated in 11 trainings held in 2017 out of which 2198 teachers have completed training.



The intake of participant has increased from 600 in the year 2017 to 3000 in April 2018 and 5000 in August 2018.

Scaling Trainings

Year 2018 is about number and impact. This year the focus will be to increase the intake of participants in each of the training and also to start evaluating the impact of the training in the transaction of the teachers in their classroom.

The Research

In early 2016, SCERT Delhi created a team of mentors to discuss, deliberate and understand the challenges being faced by teachers in the classroom.

2016

The Key learnings were:

- Many a times the subject being taught by the teacher was not her subject of specialization.
- Teacher had been teaching primary classes for a long time and needed sufficient training to become apt for teaching at the promotion level
- Too much admin work leave less time with them to go through concepts/resources again

The Challenges

Delhi SCERT saw an utmost need to address the challenges faced by the teachers in the classroom. The solution was to provide more training to teachers for their conceptual and pedagogical understanding of topics. However the conventional method that SCERT Delhi was employing before had several challenges.



The Challenges were:

- Not possible to train all teachers. Moreover frequency of trainings is low
- Tracking analytics on teachers learning and engagement is difficult to manage.
- Training outcomes highly dependent upon trainer's capability.
- **Collaboration among teachers is limited.** Attendance rate among the teachers is also low.
- **Completion rate is low. High cost involved**

The Solution

SCERT delhi started to search for solution to be able to provide more trainings to their teachers. They wanted to establish an **Online** training Program focused on providing in depth topic based trainings.



The right platform

Finally, after evaluation of several organisations such as Khan Academy, Byju, Google, Teacher App and Tata class Edge, **Million Sparks Foundation** was chosen as their education solution partner.

SCERT needs were:

- The Online Training should focus to **Improve pedagogical and conceptual understanding of teachers.**
- It should provide latest approved methodologies to teachers
- It should provide training which can be accessed by many and virtually from any -where
- It should allow teacher to continue to access content which can be updated regularly always from anywhere

The selection criteria were:

- Content understanding
- Technical capability of the organisation
- Capable Team
- Flexibility of the ChalkLit Platform
- Roadmap of the ChalkLit platform

THE PILOT

A pilot Online Capacity Building Program was launched on 5th December 2016 with 55 TGTs and 7 mentors. The pilot was launched with the objectives to seek feedback from the teachers undergoing the training to confirm that Online Mechanisms and in particular the ChalkLit platform will be an effective tool to conduct future trainings for all subjects across all grades and to identify and improve upon the mechanism and support required to conduct an effective training of teachers using Internet and Smartphones using the ChalkLit platform.

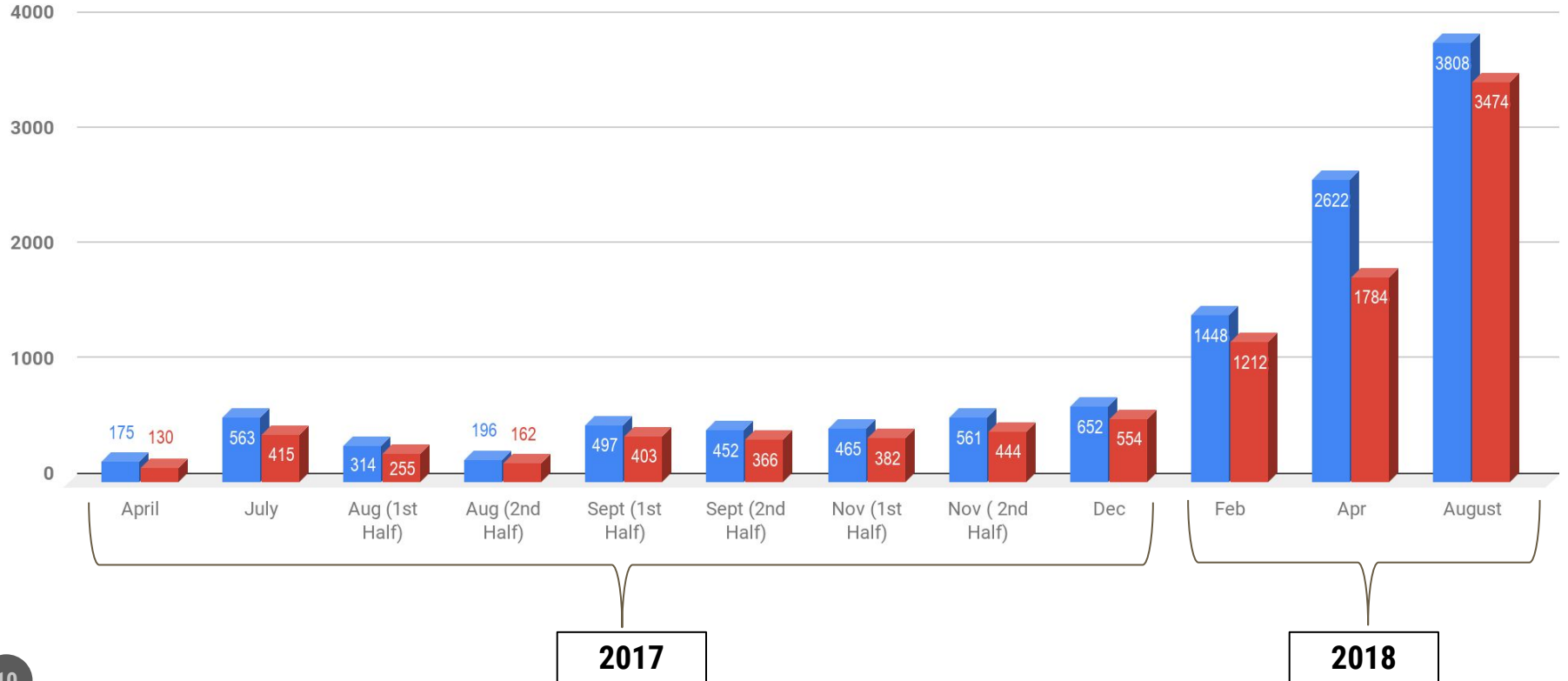
